

1                   **STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION MAKING REGULATIONS**

3   The Alexandria City School Board (Board) and Superintendent recognize the student body as a  
4   significant part of the community and in the decision making process. Alexandria City Public  
5   Schools (ACPS) has established the following methods to involve students in decision making.

7   **Student Council Associations**

8  
9   Student Council Associations (SCAs) may be formed in schools as are appropriate to the student’s  
10   maturity. SCA officers will be elected by the entire student body in an election simulating real  
11   voting conditions. The SCA will concern itself with student activities, social life, clubs, class  
12   activities, and issues of interest to students generally. Each secondary school SCA will have a  
13   written constitution developed cooperatively by students, faculty and administration.

15   **Student Representatives to the Board**

17   Student Representatives to the Board are established in accordance with Policy BBBB  
18

19   **Surveys**

21   ACPS regularly surveys the student body to gather their perspectives on a variety of topics. This  
22   information is used to inform Board and Superintendent decisions.

24   **Course Selection**

26   As students demonstrate increased maturity, they assume more responsibility for their course  
27   selection.

29   **Listening Sessions**

31   ACPS forms listening sessions and focus groups on topics of particular interest to students.
