Experimental and innovative programs that are not consistent with accreditation standards or other regulations promulgated by the Virginia Board of Education are submitted to the Chief Accountability Officer for ultimate approval by the Virginia Board of Education prior to implementation.

The parent or legal guardian of a child enrolled or engaged in any research or experimentation program or project which is funded by the United States Department of Education is entitled to inspect all instructional materials which will be used in conjunction with such program or project.

Any complaints arising under this policy may be submitted under Policies KL or KLB, as appropriate.
