Budget Advisory Committee Scope of Work 2018 - 2019

September 18, 2018

Purpose: The purpose of the Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) Budget Advisory Committee (BAC) is to advise and support the School Board regarding the budget.

Scope: The proposed scope of work for the BAC is outlined below.

- 1. Assess CIP and Combined Funds budget and provide feedback to the board on the recommendations and other process insights.
- Continue dialog between BAC and the City's Budget and Fiscal Affairs Advisory Committee (BFAAC) with 1 to 2 joint meetings to develop a more integrated BFAAC/BAC and City/ACPS budget process.
- 3. Review fiscal policies such as the fund balance policy and provide recommendations on any changes to the Board
- 4. Analyze operations metrics such as staff / student ratios and the Special Education budget funding formula, benchmark against peers and discuss best practices
- 5. Discuss possible next phase of budget risk assessment
- 6. Investigate actions to make the budget process and the budgets more user-friendly and transparent to our stakeholders and promote public participation in the ACPS budget process.

Outcome/Product: During the 2018-19 school year (FY 20 budget planning), BAC will provide the following:

- 1. Ongoing feedback through the ACPS staff liaison on a number of potential budget topics, including presentations to the board on topics covered by BAC
- 2. Joint Memo with BFAAC on budget process timing in the Spring
- 3. Memo in December on fiscal policies and feedback on the CIP plan
- Report in February on the Combined Fund budget, coordination with BFAAC/City, and recommendations on ways to communicate with the public and promote citizen engagement in the budget process.
- 5. Benchmarking, Risk analysis in May.
