OFF-SITE INSTRUCTION AND VIRTUAL COURSES

The Alexandria City School Board recognizes that individual student needs requires that the division provide instruction through a variety of formats. To support these unique learning needs Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) provides traditional in-person instruction, homebound instruction, virtual courses, and a virtual school program.

Homebound Instruction

ACPS maintains a program of homebound instruction for students who are confined at home or in a health care facility for periods that would prevent normal school attendance based upon certification of need by a licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice registered nurse, or clinical psychologist. The Superintendent or designee approves applicants for homebound instruction.

Credit for the work is awarded when it is done under the supervision of a licensed teacher qualified in the relevant subject areas and employed by the School Board, and there is evidence that the instructional time requirements or alternative means of awarding credit adopted by the Board have been met.

During home instruction, the student attendance is recorded according to regulation JEA-R Attendance Regulations.

Virtual Courses

Students may enroll in and receive a standard and verified unit of credit for supervised virtual courses with prior approval of the principal. The Superintendent is responsible for developing regulations governing this method of delivery of instruction in accordance with the regulations of the State Board of Education that include the provisions of 8 VAC 20-131-110 and the administration of required Standards of Learning tests prescribed by 8 VAC 20-131-30. For courses offered for possible high school credit, standard units of credit are awarded for successful completion of such courses when the course is equivalent to that offered in the regular school program and the work is done under the supervision of a licensed teacher qualified in the relevant subject areas. A verified unit of credit may be earned when the student has successfully completed the requirements specified in 8 VAC 20-131-110.

Credits

Any credits earned through homebound instruction or approved virtual courses are considered a part of the student's regular schoolwork and are recorded as such on the student's cumulative record.

Virtual School Program

The Virtual School Program is described in Policy IGBGA Online Courses and Virtual School Programs

HOMEBOUND, CORRESPONDENCE, AND ALTERNATIVE MEANS OF INSTRUCTION

OFF-SITE INSTRUCTION AND VIRTUAL COURSES

The Alexandria City School Board recognizes that individual student needs requires that the division provide instruction through a variety of formats. To support these unique learning needs Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) provides traditional in-person instruction, homebound instruction, virtual courses, and a virtual school program.

Homebound Instruction

ACPS shall-maintains a program of homebound instruction for students who are confined at home or in a health care facility for periods that would prevent normal school attendance based upon certification of need by a licensed physician, physician assistant, nurse practitioneradvanced practice registered nurse, or clinical psychologist. The Superintendent or designee approves applicants for homebound instruction.

Upon request of the student's parent or guardian, and provided such request is recommended by a physician, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, or clinical psychologist, ACPS shall furnish a teacher to instruct the student at home. Any credits earned shall be considered a part of the student's regular school work and recorded as such on the cumulative record. Credit for the work shall be a warded when it is done under the supervision of a certified teacher, a person eligible to hold a Virginia certificate, or other appropriately licensed professional, licensed teacher qualified in the relevant subject areas and employed by the School School Board, and there is evidence that the instructional time requirements or alternative means of awarding credit adopted by the Board have been met.

The Superintendent or designee shall approve applicants for homebound instruction. Medical forms must be maintained on file.

During <u>such period of home</u> instruction, the student <u>attendance is recorded according to regulation</u> <u>JEA-R Attendance Regulations shall be carried on the school register as present.</u>

Correspondence Virtual Courses

Students may enroll in and receive a standard and verified unit of credit for supervised virtual courses with prior approval of the principal. The Superintendent is responsible for developing regulations governing this method of delivery of instruction in accordance with the regulations of the State Board of Education that include the provisions of 8 VAC 20-131-110 and the administration of required Standards of Learning tests prescribed by 8 VAC 20-131-30. For courses offered for possible high school credit, standard units of credit are awarded for successful completion of such courses when the course is equivalent to that offered in the regular school program and the work is done under the supervision of a licensed teacher qualified in the relevant subject areas. A verified unit of credit may be earned when the student has successfully completed the requirements specified in 8 VAC 20-131-110., at the direction and for the adoption of the School Board and in accordance with the Standards of Accreditation, will develop guidelines governing the enrollment of students in supervised correspondence courses for receipt of standard

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Standard units of credit will be awarded for the successful completion of such courses when the course is equivalent to that offered in the regular school program and the work is done under the supervision of a licensed teacher, or a person eligible to hold a Virginia license, approved by the School Board. Verified units of credit may be earned when the student has passed the SOL test associated with the correspondence course completed.

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Instruction through Alternative Technological Means

The Superintendent, at the direction and for the adoption of the School Board and in accordance with the Standards of Accreditation, shall develop guidelines for students who enroll in high school as freshmen before July 1, 2018, as sophomores before July 1, 2019, as juniors before July 1, 2020 or as seniors before July 1, 2021 to encourage the pursuit of alternative means to deliver instruction to accommodate student needs through emerging technologies.

Standard units of credit will be awarded for the successful completion of such courses when the course is equivalent to that offered in the regular school program and the work is done under the supervision of a licensed teacher, or a person eligible to hold a Virginia license, approved by the School Board. Verified units of credit may be earned when the student has passed the SOL test associated with the correspondence course completed.

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Credits

Any credits earned through homebound instruction or approved virtual courses are considered a part of the student's regular -schoolwork and are recorded as such on the student's cumulative
