





Protocol for Media Inquiries

- All media inquiries are handled by ED of communications and media relations specialist
- Team coordinates responses with subject matter experts
- Responses approved by chief of school & community relations who serves as official ACPS spokesperson
- School Board chair is official spokesperson for the Board











Protocol for SB Media Responses

- Upon receipt of any media inquiries, SB members send request to School Board chair
- School Board chair forwards to chief of school & community relations and superintendent (for awareness)
- School Board chair does not respond
- Depending on request, chair and superintendent may strategize on response
- Chief of school & community relations handles all responses on behalf of SB once response is agreed upon











Rationale for School Board Media Protocol

- Communications Team receives numerous inquiries throughout the week
- Each inquiry receives a timely response and we coordinate and strategize on responses
- Imperative that we are in unison as School Board and division
- When individual Board members respond to inquiries, in many cases, it may not be aligned with what division is preparing as a response
- It may also not be ready to be shared for factors that are germane to staff discussions

School Board Media Training for Chairs

- The Communications Team will train the School Board chair to participate in media interviews
- A prep meeting and talking points are shared with chair prior to interviews
- Rare to have Chair in interviews
- Chair will also be quoted for various stories or in press releases












Media Relations Web Page & RoundUp

- Superintendent's voice
 - Monthly "Supe's Spotlight" video message in newsletters
