

- **Guide Families** through the Registration Process
- Hold Kindergarten Virtual Open Houses and School Tours
- **Distribute** Summer Activity Choice Boards
- **Distribute** "Getting Your Child Ready for Kindergarten" Booklet
- **Hold** "Step Up to Kindergarten"
 - July 25, 2022: Samuel W. Tucker Elementary School
 - August 19, 2022: All Other ACPS Elementary Schools





Elementary Transition

- **Have** Teachers and Case Managers *Reach Out to Families*
- Hold Open House Events Prior to The First Day of School
- Host Back to School Nights
 - August 11, 2022: Samuel Tucker ES
 - September 15, 2022: All Other Elementary Schools
- **Have** 5th Graders *Meet with School Counselors* to Complete Course Requests for 6th Grade
- **Conduct** *Middle School Visits*
- Hold Moving-up Day Activities (Vary Among Schools)
- **Celebrate** 5th Grade *Promotion Ceremonies*







K-8 School Transition *Moving Up Day*

- **Have** K-7 Students *Visit Classrooms* and *Teachers* in the Next Grade Level
- **Ensure** Students *Learn What to Expect* During the Upcoming School Year by:
 - **Participating** in *Q&A* Sessions

 - Reviewing Grade-Level Curriculum
- Send A Grade-Level Overview to Families
- Have Other Activities Align to Traditional Elementary and Middle School Transitions


