CLASSROOM ASSIGNMENTS FOR TWINS

A parent/guardian of twins or higher order multiples in the same grade-level may request that the children be placed in the same classroom or in separate classrooms if they are at the same elementary school.

- The parent/legal guardian must request the classroom placement no later than three days
 after the first day of each school year or three days after the first day of attendance of the
 children during a school year;
- school may recommend classroom placement to the parent/guardian;
- schools must provide the placement requested by the children's parent/guardian, unless the division superintendent or his designee makes a classroom placement determination following the school principal's request in accordance with this policy; and
- at the end of the initial grading period, if the school principal, in consultation with the children's classroom teacher, determines that the requested classroom placement is disruptive to the school or is harmful to the children's educational progress, the school principal may request that the division superintendent or his designee determine the children's classroom placement.

A parent/guardian must request the classroom placement no later than 3 days after the first day of each school year or 3 days after the first day of attendance of the children during a school year. Schools may recommend classroom placement to the parent/guardian.

In the event of a parent/guardian request made in accordance with the preceding paragraph, schools must provide the placement requested by the children's parent/guardian, unless the division Superintendent or designee makes a classroom placement determination following the school principal's request, at the end of the initial grading period, and in consultation with the children's classroom teacher and parent(s)/guardian(s) based upon a determination that the requested classroom placement is disruptive to the school or is harmful to the children's educational progress.
