SUMMARY:

On December 14th, Alexandria City Public Schools received a donation of \$150,000 from Amazon to support ACPS identified students that continue to need child/full-day school care. In accordance with ACPS Policy KH and Regulation KH-R, any donation over \$2,500 requires School Board approval. The donation must meet the established standards of acceptance requirements. Those standards and the appropriate responses are detailed below:

ACPS Donation Standards of Acceptance

1. Have a purpose consistent with the goals of ACPS;

The donation supports educational equity for ACPS students by providing full day child/school day care for identified students of vulnerable families during the Covid-19 pandemic. This donation aligns with ACPS 2020 Strategic Goal 3,4, and 5.

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2. Impose no undesirable, unacceptable, or hidden costs in terms of resources to ACPS;

The donation has no identified undesirable, unacceptable, or hidden costs.

3. Place no unacceptable conditions or restrictions on the school division or its educational or extracurricular programs;

This donation will place no unacceptable conditions or restrictions on the school division or its educational or extracurricular programs.

4. Not assume that the School Board will accept responsibility for continuing the benefit of or program supported by the donation if or when the funds are exhausted;

The Office of Community Partnerships and Engagement will continue to monitor the child care/school day care Virtual PLUS+ partners with multiple other ACPS Departments. It is assumed that the ACPS School Board will not have any further action or responsibility related to this donation.

5. Meet any applicable federal, state, and/or local laws and regulations, Board policies, regulations or guidelines associated with its construction or use; and meet any applicable safety standards.

This donation meets all local laws, regulations, Board policies, regulations and guidelines.

BACKGROUND:

With the continuation of the ACPS Virtual PLUS+ model of instruction, the opportunity for child care/school day care for our most vulnerable families continues to be needed in a virtual education environment. To help address this need, ACPS and multiple Virtual PLUS+ partners, collaborated to create a full day free care program at multiple sites for identified students. Amazon's donation will support the ability for ACPS to continue the care program for our families.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Superintendent recommends that the School Board accept the donation to ACPS in the amount of \$150,000.

IMPACT:

This donation will help support ACPS students in need of full day child care.
