V. Old Business and Action Items

- Follow-up on vaccination:
 - Tamm Ignacio has followed up with the board on it. Once a permanent superintendent starts, we can have a timeline for vaccination requirements.

VI. New Business and Reports

Ursula Rocha and Victor Martin presented on SEAL and MTSS (multisystem supports) - Tier1, 2, 3 as it relates to Socio-emotional learning.

- Academic, social and emotional, and behavioral supports are given to students; teachers also get support through MTSS
- Start with building community first



- Multiple sources of data (COVID screener, DESSA screener, disciplinary supports, threat/risk assessments, etc.)
- Why MTSS?
 - Facilitates equity of access, data-informed approach, aligns with teaching and learning framework empowers teachers, facilitates family engagement, and supports dynamic response
- When MTSS is used successfully, it lowers referrals, school, and community engagement
- MTSS supports pandemic recovery
- Victor gave the personal experience of discipline referrals lowered by 84% at detention centers using MTSS
- Supports in place in Tier 1 are led by staff, Tier 2 led by SST, Tier 3 led by SST
- Ursula mentioned "community circles" being used through SEAL
- SEAL the process through which children and adults understand and manage emotions
 - Differentiated based on grade level and each school needs

Student representative shared student data and a quote from a PTAC member that SEAL is not valued, students are not paying attention, and "ACPS does not care for your mental health" based on students she asked. Mentioned mental health has been affected by the loss of Lunch and Learn deadlines, not well-used PRIDE time for SEAL lessons, and lack of mental health access.

- Feels we need more therapists available to students.

A member mentioned groupings of students when SEAL is taught and has ACPS thought of creating common interest groups
