

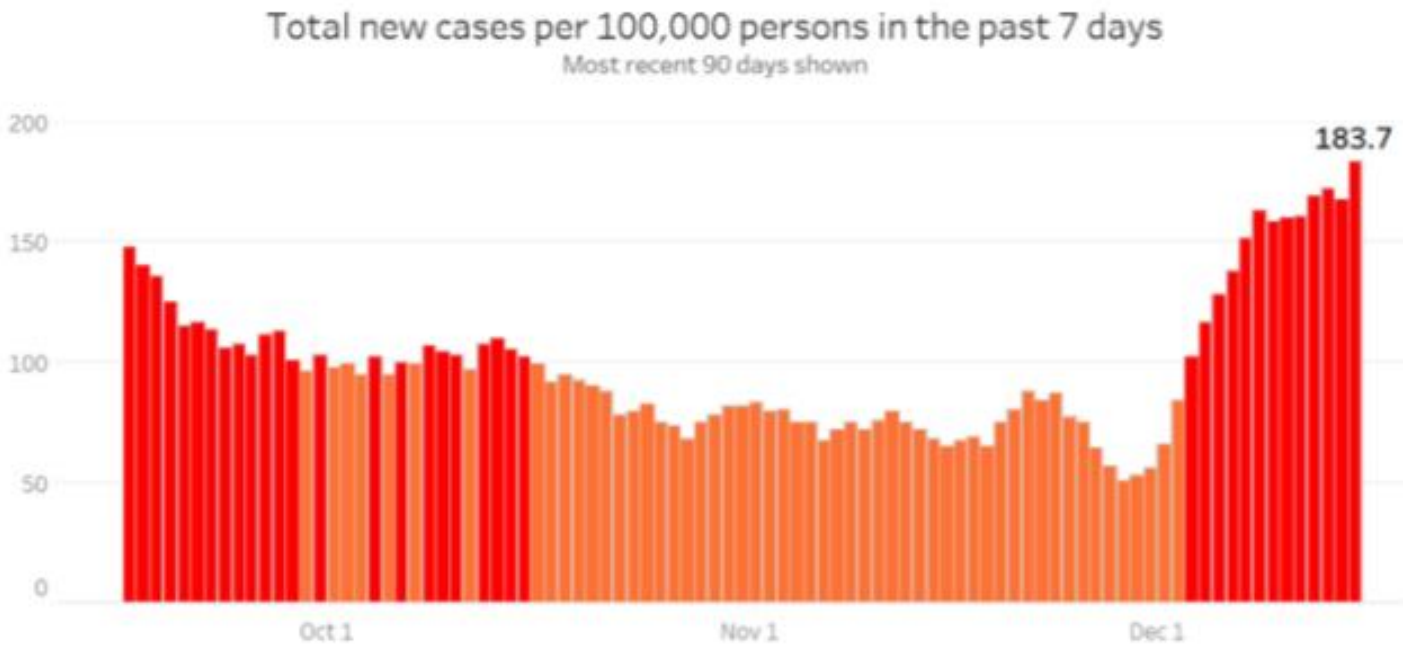

COVID-19 Cases

ACPS is seeing a **significant increase** in positive cases since the Thanksgiving break.

- Last week (December 6-13): 40 positive cases
- This week (December 14-16, 12:30PM): 52 positive cases
 - 30 positive cases reported for Wednesday, December 15th
 - 38 students and 14 staff cases

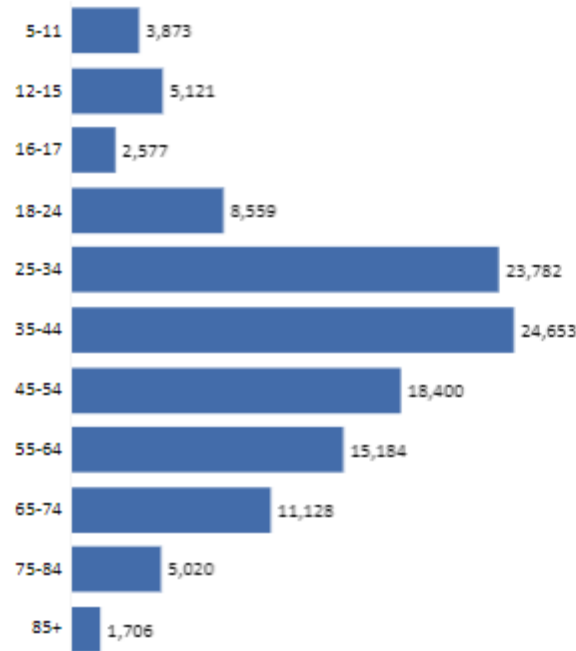

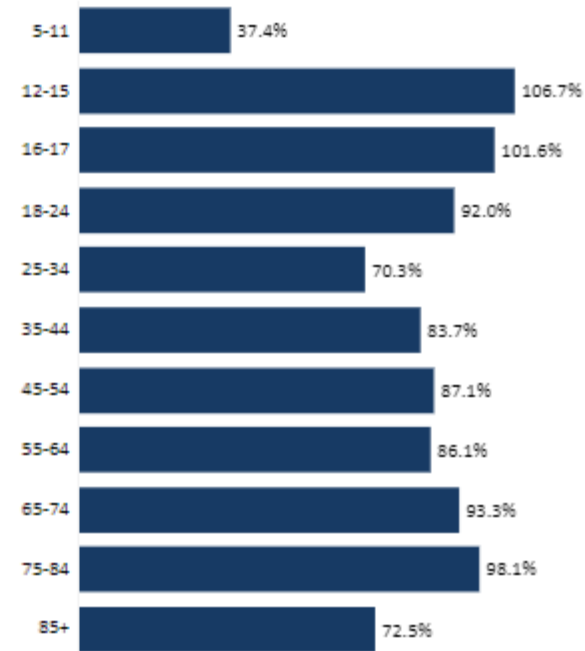


Vaccinations

COVID-19 Dashboard

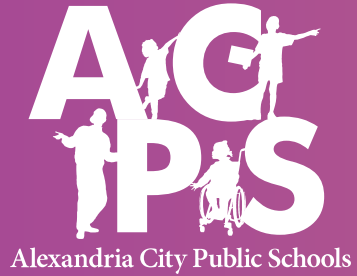
- Real-time dashboard will be made available by mid-January
