 - 3. How are these data informing your decisions?
 - 4. Successes in the data? Concerns in the data?
 - 5. Where have you gotten stuck?
 - ii. Teacher monitoring and decision making:
 - 1. Which data are teachers using to make informed decisions in classroom instruction?
 - 2. How are data being used in PLCs?
 - 3. Which data are being used to monitor student progress in interventions?
 - 4. How have adjustments been made to interventions/groupings?
