I.	COVID-19 Update	Still in medium community impact level based on the number of cases per 100K residents of the last seven days and not severity of the cases. We have seen about 119 new cases per day over the last seven days. AHD continues to promote taking infection prevention measures, such as wearing masks, testing, increased vaccinations and boosters. Will continue to support activities through the City related to vaccinations and supporting ACPS at their vaccination information events. Boosters are now recommended for everyone 5 years and older. As of now only Pfizer is available for those under 17 years. In mid-June, the FDA Vaccine and Related Biological Products Advisory Committee with meet to discuss Moderna's request for ages 6 months to 5 years /ages 6 to 17, and Pfizers' request for 6 months to 4 years.
