February 2019	Human Resources <b>posted summer employment</b> <b>opportunities</b> for teachers and paraprofessionals
April 2019 - Present	Monthly summer learning meetings for principals, coordinators, curriculum staff, and Central Office

January 2019	ACPS posted all the summer learning opportunities on the ACPS website and in the ACPS Insider
March 20, 2019	Invitations for the 3 <sup>rd</sup> through 8 <sup>th</sup> grade summer learning program were mailed to families
May 21, 2019	High school summer learning (including AP boot camp) <b>registration opened</b> for families
June 2019	Students for ESY, EL summer enrichment, summer language academy, Young Scholars, and Title I primary preparation will <b>receive opening day information</b>
