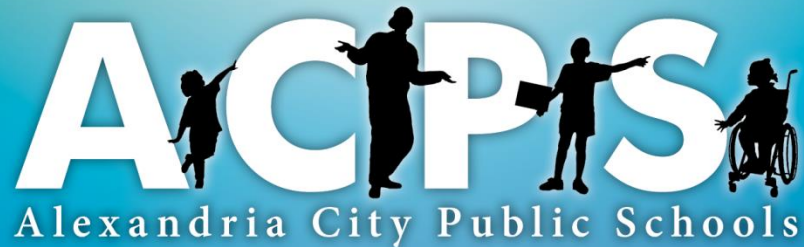

March 20, 2019

Invitations for the 3rd through 8th grade summer learning program were mailed to families

May 21, 2019

High school summer learning (including AP boot camp) **registration opened** for families

June 2019

Students for ESY, EL summer enrichment, summer language academy, Young Scholars, and Title I primary preparation will **receive opening day information**

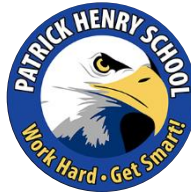

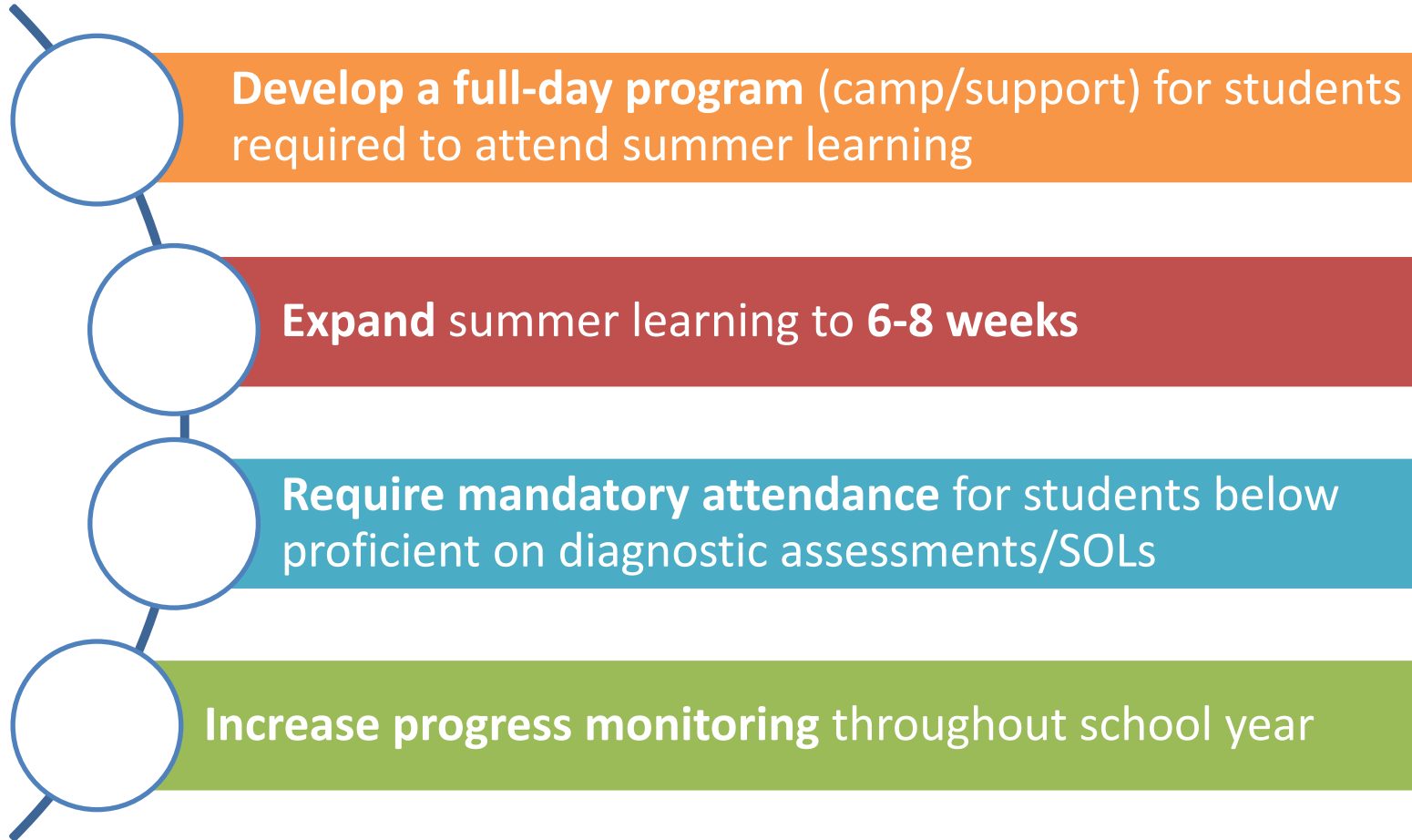
