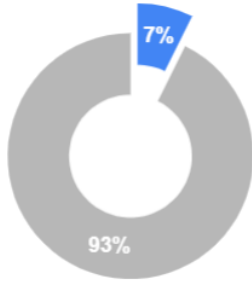

VirtualPLUS+ Opening of School Data

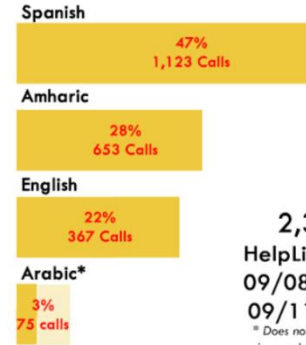
Estimated seven percent of students attended less than 50% of days in the first week of school.



78% of students logged into Clever during the first week of school.
