#### SUMMARY:

Preliminary year- to-date report of revenue and expenditures as of October 31, 2022.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

School Board Policy DI, Financial Accounting and Reporting, requires the preparation and issuance of monthly financial reports. Monthly reports are provided to the School Board for the three primary funds covering school division operations: Operating Fund, Grants and Special Projects Fund, and School Nutrition Fund.

These preliminary financial reports show the FY 2023 Final Budget as adopted by the School Board on June 02, 2022, the revised budget of record as of October 31, 2022 including all

adjustments and transfers, all actual revenue earned and expenditures incurred, and all encumbrances booked in this same period. Also included are the remaining balances for each revenue and expenditure line item. These reports are considered preliminary because the accounting period was not officially closed at the time this report was prepared.

A separate report showing all budget transfers exceeding \$25,000 for the reporting month is attached. There are 15 budget transfers meeting this criterion in October. Funds were transferred within schools and/or departments for the following reasons:

**Operating Fund** 

- Within James K. Polk to fund for additional Custodian Intermittent pay due to vacancies
- Within Facilities and Operations to fund for Custodial services at 1703 N. Beauregard
- Within ACHS Minnie Howard to fund School Engagement/Community Services
- Within Facilities and Operations to fund for HVAC Maintenance contract

Grant and Special Projects

- Within Patrick Henry Title I Part A Grant for fund instructional supplies across all grades
- Within Instructional Supports' ESSER II Grant to reflect amended grant priorities and reallocation of resources
- Within James K. Polk Title I Part A Grant for fund technology equipment
- From various Departments/Offices' ESSER III Grant to provide for reprioritize social, emotional, and academic supports by reprioritizing vacancy savings to fund professional services from contracted vendors, in addition to other services
