

VANDALISM

The School Board urges staff members, students, and the public to cooperate in the reduction of vandalism by reporting incidents of vandalism and the name(s) of any person(s) believed to be responsible to the principal or the Department of Educational Facilities.

The School Board may ~~institute take~~ action and recover from the parents/guardian(s) ~~or either of them~~ of any minor or adult student living with ~~such parents/guardian(s)~~ one or both of them, ~~or either of them~~ up to \$2500 for damages suffered by reason of the willful or malicious destruction of, or damage to, public property by ~~such minor~~ the minor or adult student.

In addition, a student who damages or destroys public property will be subject to whatever disciplinary action is deemed necessary and advisable by the school principal or appropriate legal authority.
