The disclosure statement is filed on or before the day the Superintendent assumes employment for the preceding 6 12-month period complete through the last day of the month immediately preceding the month in 7 which the Superintendent assumes employment. However, if the Superintendent assumes 8 employment in January, the Superintendent files a disclosure form on or before February 1 for the 9 preceding year complete through December 31. Completed forms are filed and maintained as 10 public records for five years in the office of the Clerk of the Alexandria City School Board.
