

## SPECIAL CALLED SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

The School Board holds sSpecial and eContinued mMeetings ~~when necessary, for purposes such as School Board retreats, in-depth topics, to address short-notice action items, or when necessary. They are held at the discretion of the School Board Leadership or on request by the majority of School Board Members, who have notified the Chair. Special Meetings may be called provided each member is duly notified, or a reasonable attempt has been made to notify each member. Special meetings are held when called by the Chair or when requested by two or more members. Special meetings may be called provided each member is duly notified, or a reasonable attempt has been made to notify each member.~~

Business that does not come within the purposes set forth in the call of the meeting is not transacted at any special meeting of the School Board unless the members present unanimously agree to consider additional items of business.

Notice, reasonable under the circumstances, of sSpecial or Ceontinued MMeetings is given contemporaneously with the notice provided to members of the School Board.
