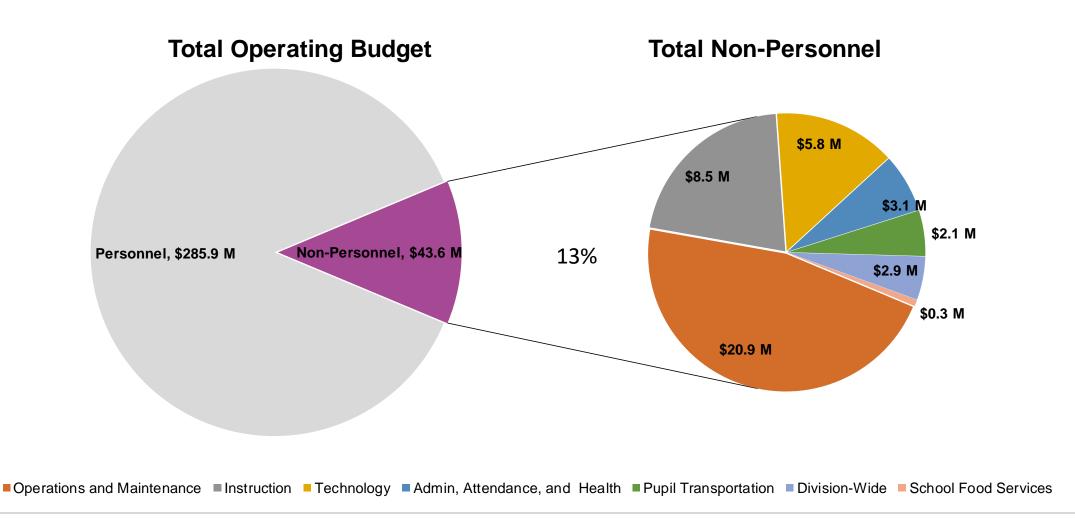








Non-Personnel Expenditures







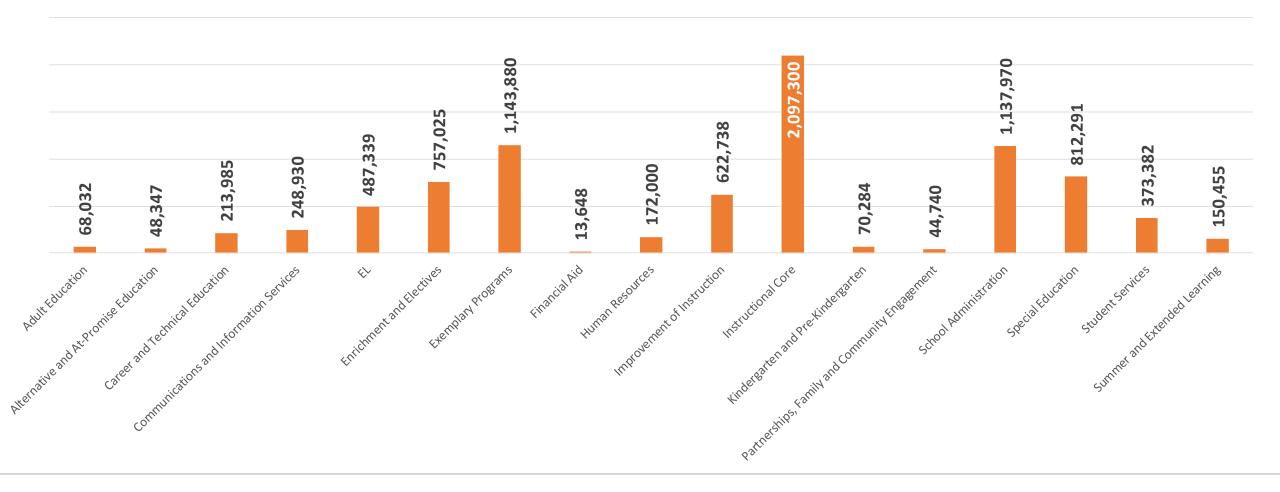

- Funding for Manipulative Kits





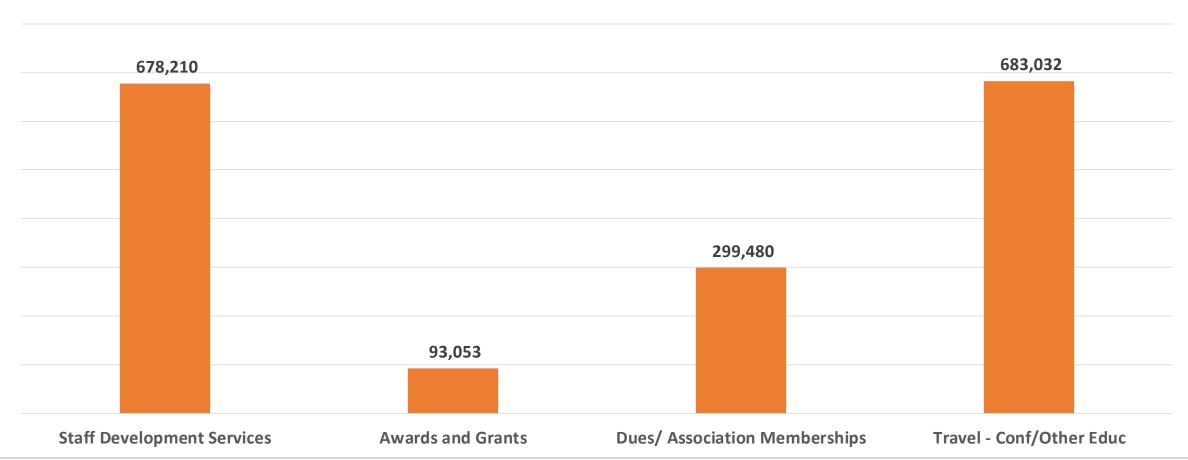

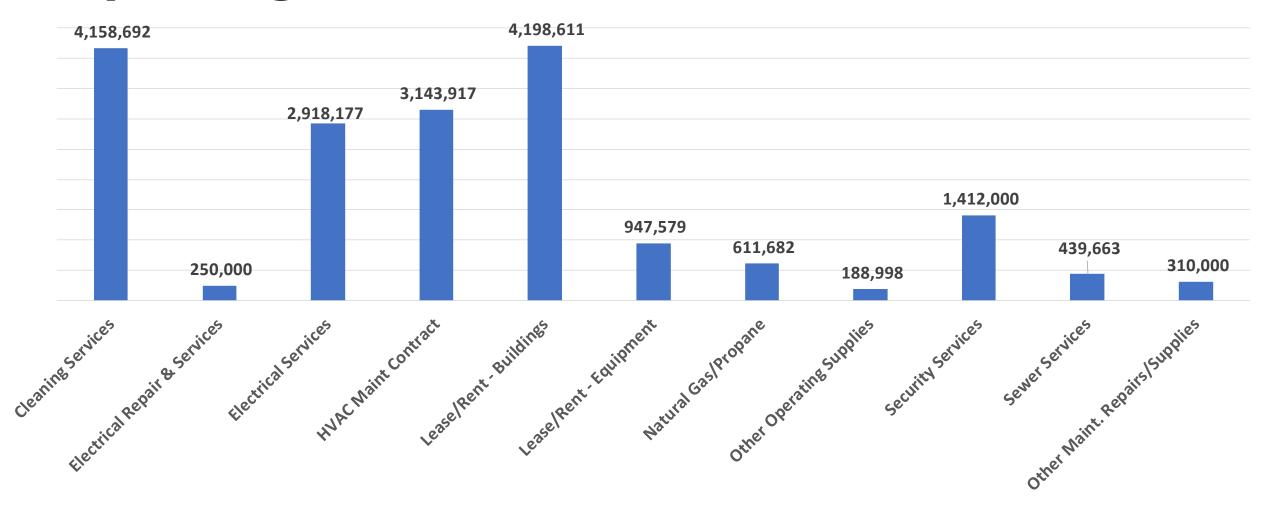

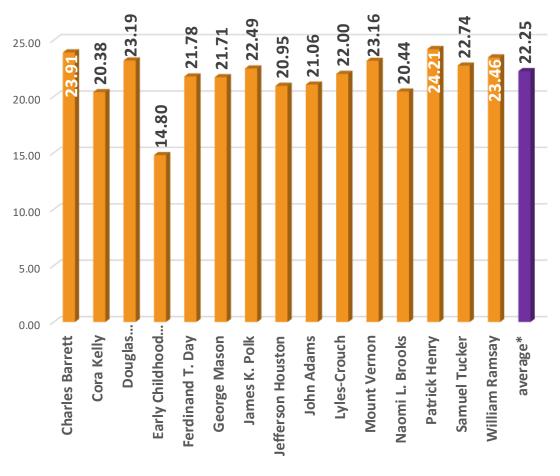








Projected Class Sizes (Elementary Homeroom)

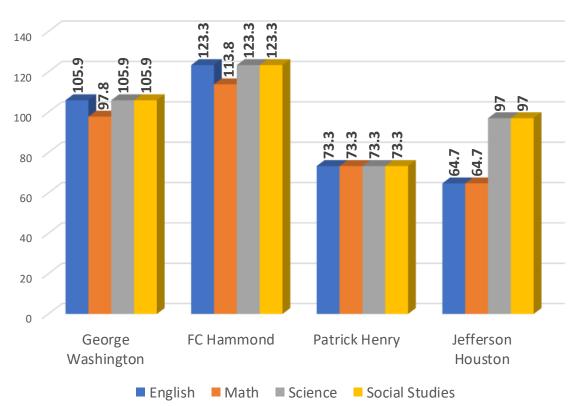






Projected Class Sizes (Middle School Core)





- Standard student to teacher ratio shall be no greater than 150 to 1
- Standard PE and Music teacher ratio is 200 to 1
- Teachers with more than 150 (200 for PE and Music) students are provided a compensation adjustment



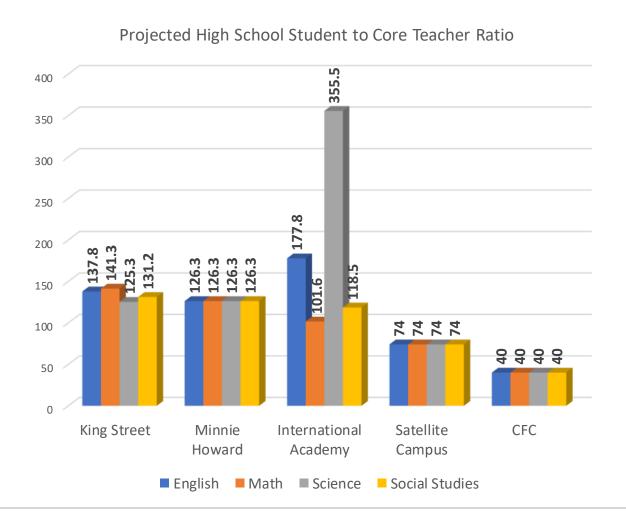








Projected Student to Core Teacher (High School)



- Standard student to teacher ratio shall be no greater than 150 to 1
- Standard PE and Music teacher ratio is 200 to 1
- Teachers with more than 150 (200 for PE and Music) students are provided a compensation adjustment
