Purpose of the Program of Studies

- Begins the advisement period for students and families
- Provides guidance for Individualized Career and Academic Planning (ICAPs)
- Outlines schedule possibilities at all grade levels
- Links school-based learning with the knowledge and skills required for success in the workplace
- Offers steps for academic and career planning for grades 6-12
- Includes course requirements and expectations
- Defines graduation requirements
- Provides information about academies (STEM Academy, International Academy, Academy of Health Sciences, Academy of Finance)
- Lists support offered to students
- Provides students and families with a list of course offerings

Profile of a Graduate

- "Profile of a Virginia Graduate," a set of skills and attributes identified by employers and higher education as critical for success in the workplace and in college
- Passed November 16, 2017
- Reduces the number of SOL tests students must pass to earn a high school diploma





Profile of a Graduate

- Increased emphasis on the practical application of learned skills
- Expanding the use of performance-based assessments for the awarding of verified credits
- Inclusion of career-planning component
