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DRIVER EDUCATION

ACPS shall offer a program of driver education in the safe operation of motor vehicles and knowledge of rules, regulations and laws in the high school. The program shall consist of class-room training and shall include instruction concerning alcohol and drug abuse, aggressive driving, motorcycle awareness, distracted driving, and organ and tissue donor awareness, fuel-efficient driving practices and traffic stops, including law-enforcement procedures for traffic stops, appropriate actions to be taken by drivers during traffic stops and appropriate interactions with law-enforcement officers who initiate traffic stops.

ACPS shall provide the necessary certification of students' academic standing and compliance with compulsory attendance laws to the Department of Motor Vehicles upon request, in accordance with state law.

At the beginning of each school year and thereafter as necessary, the Superintendent shall report to the Department of Motor Vehicles the name and driver's license number of all persons providing instruction in driver education for the school division.
