**TOPIC:** Summer Learning Preview

**BACKGROUND**

For the last four summers, Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) has provided summer learning opportunities for all students ranging from kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Previously, summer learning opportunities were only offered to students who participated in Extended School Year (ESY), English Language Program, and High School Summer Enrichment. Currently, ACPS offers:

High School Programs, Online Courses, Credit Recovery, Advanced Placement (AP) Boot Camp, Governor’s Health Sciences Academy Prep
Middle School Programs, Middle School Enrichment, Drama Camp, Algebra Boot Camp, Transition to Algebra, Music Camp, Young Scholars, Higher Achievement
Elementary School Programs, Elementary School Enrichment, Young Scholars, Band Camp, Kindergarten Prep
English Language Learner Summer Enrichment
Extended School Year (ESY)
Summer Language Academy
Title I Primary Preparation Program
