# Summer Learning for All Continuity of Learning Plan for Special Education Summer 2020

During this unprecedented time, ACPS is offering every student the opportunity to expand or refine their learning by providing summer learning through engagement and enrichment for all students. Students with disabilities will be provided special education support and/or direct instruction in coursework focused on English/Language Arts (ELA) and Math. Differentiated levels of support will be provided based on individual students' needs. Secondary students with disabilities will be provided the opportunity to participate in new credit and credit recovery courses offered to all students, as well as other options appropriate for their learning needs. Elementary students with disabilities will be provided grade level learning packets with differentiated support based on individual student needs, as well as other options to address targeted learning needs. Students will continue to receive related services through a teletherapy model.

Current Special Education Case Managers will make recommendations for course participation and differentiated levels of summer learning special education support.

## **Participation Options**

## High School Students with Disabilities (Current 8th - 12th grade)

### **Online Summer School for New Credit Courses**

These virtual classes for new credit are available to current 9th, 10th and 11th grade students in the following courses (fee required\*). Special education support or direct instruction will vary based on individual students' needs in the following courses:

- English
- Math

\* Any student whose circumstances have been impacted by COVID-19 or is eligible for Free or Reduced Price Meals can access these classes for free by contacting their school counselor.

### Online Summer School for Credit Recovery (repeat courses)

These are virtual classes that a student may need repeating or retaking and are free of charge for any student needing credit recovery. Special education support or direct instruction will vary based on individual students' needs in the following courses:

- English
- Math

### Boost/Prep classes for Math and English (not for credit)

Boost courses for English and mathematics are designed to help support students in preparing for their next grade level content. These online courses are available to students with disabilities, as appropriate, and are accessible through their Chromebooks. Special education support or direct instruction will vary based on individual students' needs.

#### **ACPS Reading or Math Intervention Programs**

Students with disabilities who require targeted reading or math intervention can participate in virtual intervention lessons during summer learning. Special education support or direct instruction will vary based on individual students' needs.

## Middle School Students with Disabilities (Current 5<sup>th</sup>- 7<sup>th</sup> grade)

#### **Boost Prep Classes in Math and English**

Boost courses for English and mathematics are designed to help support students in preparing for their next grade level content. These online courses are available to students with disabilities, as appropriate, and are accessible through their Chromebooks. Special education support or direct instruction will vary based on individual students' needs.

#### **ACPS Reading or Math Intervention Programs**

Students with disabilities who may require targeted reading or math intervention can participate in virtual intervention lessons during summer learning. Special education support or direct instruction will vary based on individual students' needs.

#### Elementary School (Current Grades K – 4)

#### **Learning Activity Packets**

ACPS will provide students in grades kindergarten through fourth with a variety of hands-on activities and resources in Learning Activity Packets to help them continue to learn and grow during the summer. Special education support or direct instruction will vary based on individual students' needs.

#### **ACPS Reading or Math Intervention Programs**

Students with disabilities who may require targeted reading or math intervention can participate in virtual intervention lessons during summer learning. Special education support or direct instruction will vary based on individual students' needs and as outlined in the chart below.

#### Students in City Wide Special Education Programs (Grades K - PG)

Students with disabilities who currently require special education supports and services in a city wide classroom placement will be provided differentiated content during summer learning for all. Activities aligned to the student's needs and skill levels will be delivered on the same schedule outlined for each grade level. Content will be differentiated to ensure access for all citywide students and lessons will be tailored to address the needs of students in the areas of reading and math. Learning activities will integrate a mixture of online guided lessons and independent practice activities.

#### Related Services (Grades K - PG)

Related services of Speech Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Physical Therapy will be offered to mitigate loss of skill development during summer months. Therapists will contact parents to arrange a schedule for summer teletherapy services.

#### **Summer Learning Participation Recommendations**

#### **Students with Disabilities**

Course recommendations for participation will be made by current case managers based on student data. Student data will be used to establish a tier for recommending student course participation and differentiated special education support. Special Education case managers will review data for each student on their caseload and determine tier (Table 1) and recommend participation and differentiated support (Tables 2, 3 & 4) based on the guidelines below.
