SUMMARY:

The Department of Teaching, Learning, and Leadership has implemented the vision of the 2018 Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) School Board's approved concept of the *Connected High School Network* with the expansion of the Minnie Howard Campus to a full 9–12 educational program that is part of the Academies of Alexandria City. The Academies at Alexandria City is a learner-centered instructional program that allows students from diverse populations to explore and develop the skills that are needed for students to be prepared for college, career, and life beyond the classroom and high school.

DETAILS:

Since the November 30, 2024 approval of the full Secondary Program of Studies, The High School Project (THSP) team has worked to fully develop the School Board approved academy structure. The Alexandria City High School (ACHS) Administrative team has finalized a student-centered bell schedule and planned strategies to foster and progress monitor the successful implementation of the academy structure through the implementation of a staggered start. ACHS school counselors have engaged with students, staff, and families in the academic advisement process. Finally, the ACHS Director of School Counseling and ACPS Director of Education and Business Applications have worked collaboratively in the development and completion of the 2024–2025 ACHS master schedule.

BACKGROUND:

The High School Project (THSP) team continues to plan for the educational experience of students at Alexandria City High School (ACHS) with core values and drivers of instructional excellence, equity, student achievement and growth, and multiple pathways that prepare students for college, career, and civic life.
