The Committee will continue to use quantitative and qualitative data, including the experiences of Alexandria's diverse communities, to develop objectives, measures, and strategies for increasing equity.



TIMELINE

The work the committee is doing today is driving the development and finalization of the strategic plan, which will take place over the next 4 months:

- Jan. 8 SPC Meeting: Review KPIs, objectives, and measures; start work on strategies
- Jan. 22 SPC Meeting: Review "final" KPIs, objectives, and measures; continue finalizing draft strategies in groups; and review entire plan
- February: Finalization of draft strategic plan based on ACPS feedback
- Early March: Presentation of draft strategic plan to the ACPS School Board
- March/April: Public comment on the draft strategic plan
- Late April: Presentation of final draft of the strategic plan to the ACPS School Board

- Kindergarten readiness
- Student growth and proficiency in reading (by student subgroup)
- Student growth and proficiency in mathematics proficiency (by subgroup)
- Percentage of students (by subgroup) chronically absent, as a measure of social-emotional health and overall wellbeing
- Percentage of students (by race) identified with a disability
- Percentage of 9th graders on target to graduate high school in 4 years (by subgroup)
- Percentage of students (by subgroup) who graduate high school ready for the next step on their preferred postsecondary pathway (incl. approved CTE credential or completion of an AP, honors, or IB course)




