LOCALLY AWARDED VERIFIED CREDITS

Panel members will consist of:

(1) The T.C. Williams test coordinator or representative of the Central Office Monitoring & Evaluation Department of Accountability;

(2) <u>The Director of Counseling and the Aappropriate department chairperson or division</u> curriculum specialist.counselor;

(3) <u>Grade level administrator The Dean of Students</u>, high school principal, or <u>and the</u> Executive Director of Secondary <u>EducationInstruction</u>.

Information to be <u>collected and</u> presented by the student's <u>counselor</u> to the panel will include:

(1) classroom assignments

(2) course grade(s)

(3) papers, projects, essays, written assignments

The panel should take into consideration that a student might not have kept assignments from a teacher. Failure to provide 1 or 3 above will not exclude a student from receiving the credit. However, the panel may require additional academic assignments or testing to determine adequate knowledge of Standards of Learning content.
