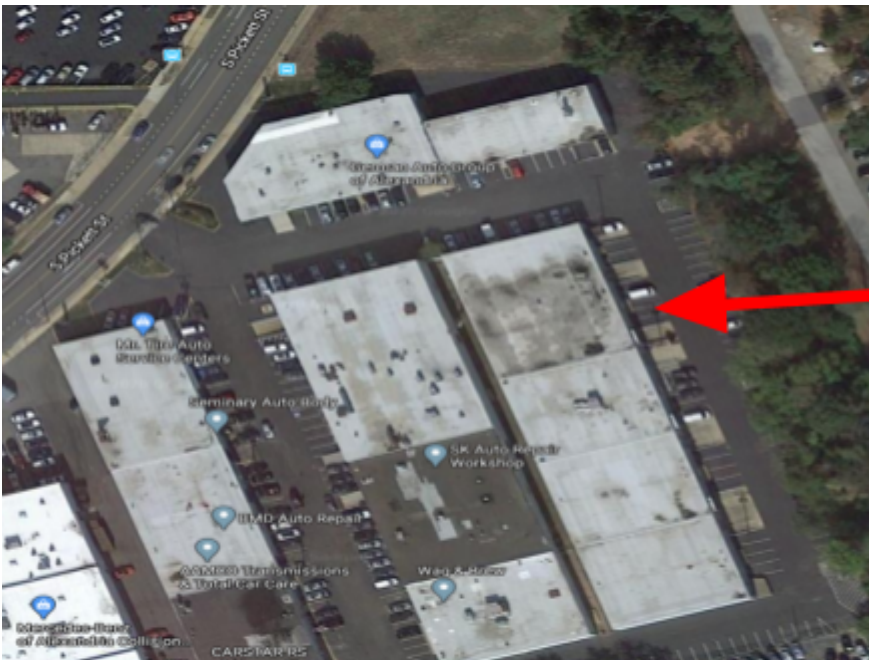

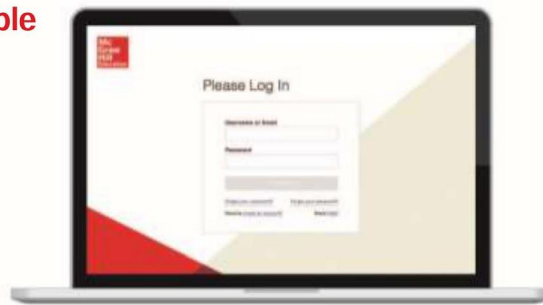

To make the most of your 30 minutes, NoRedInk has created these step by step instructions along with general time estimates, so you can get a sample of what most of our writing program offers. If you finish early, you'll have a pretty good sense of how to get around the site, and there are many things you can go back to explore!

Play around with NoRedInk's library of grammar and writing exercises. (8 min)

Step 1: Go to Curriculum.

Step 2: Select the Writing tab

Step 3: Go to Browse By Genre

Step 4: Select Argumentative

Step 5: Select Practice and Assessment

Step 6. Click on Body Paragraphs: Claims, Evidence, and Reasoning to view the whole pathway.

Step 7. Click the eye icon to preview the Identifying Claims, Evidence, and Reasoning exercise.

Step 8. Play around with that exercise and submit mistakes to see how our engine remediates.

Once finished, spend the remainder of the 8 minutes previewing other exercises of your choosing in other pathways. I would also browse the Conventions skills area if you're not familiar with the grammar piece. Favorites of mine include Checkpoint: Avoiding Plagiarism When Paraphrasing, Checkpoint: Revising Wordiness, and Review: Building a Paragraph with Transitions. You can also search for any term in the search bar at the top left.
