### **Capacity Projects Update**



- **In FY24 Q3**: Phase I neared completion during this quarter.
  - Interior and exterior finishes were largely completed.
  - Life safety systems were completed and inspected in February which were required to obtain a stocking peppermint in March.
  - Furniture and equipment installation began in March and completed in April.
  - Paving, playground, and landscaping completed.
  - Certificate of Temporary Occupancy awarded April 3rd.
  - Planning for relocation into the new facility.
- **Anticipated in FY24 Q4**: Phase I will be completed including all punch list work and relocation of faculty and staff into the new building. Phase II will begin starting with securing the area and abatement of the existing building.

Douglas MacArthur

- In FY24 Q3: Athletic field and playground installation complete and inspection successfully completed. Playground is open for school and public use. Landscaping is completed. Monument sign installed and power connected.
- **Anticipated in FY24 Q4**: Interior and exterior punchlist to be completed. Wayfinding signs installation to be completed.



## **Capacity Projects Update**



- In FY24 Q3: Interior friable asbestos removed, Final Clearance Letter issued by ECS. Old Patrick Henry School demolished, rubble to be segregated and hauled off-site. Site grading ongoing, including installation of underground stormwater system. Eastern retaining wall foundations excavated, placed, and wall forming initiated.
- Anticipated in FY24 Q4: Eastern monumental stairs, bike runnel, handicap ramp, and sidewalks formed and placed. Forming and placing new concrete curb islands in parking area underway. Stormwater structures and underground piping in progress. Preparation work for future site lighting underway. Site grading and surplus soil removal ongoing.

1703 N. Beauregard

- In FY24 Q3: Interior demolition completed.
- **Anticipated in FY24 Q4:** Anticipated approval of GMP 2 and 3. In this phase, all city permits will be obtained as well as approved construction set drawings and site plan. GMP 2 work will commence, starting with the mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems (MEP) and fire protection.

Transportation Center (Witter Wheeler)


- **In FY24 Q2:** Phase II assessment of facility and future facility recommendations to be analyzed.
- **Anticipated in FY24 Q3:** Initial bell schedule study draft to be analyzed by staff.


